You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

Type

The product is a share class of the Flossbach von Storch SICAV - Multiple Opportunities sub-fund, which is part of Flossbach von Storch SICAV (the "Umbrella Fund"), an open-ended investment company with variable capital (société d'investissement à capital variable – SICAV) that has been established in the form of an umbrella fund and is subject to Part II of the Luxembourg Law of 17 December 2010 (Law of 2010), as amended, and thus qualifies as an alternative investment fund. The assets and liabilities of each sub-fund are segregated by law.

Term

The product has an unlimited term. Notwithstanding this, the product may at any time be liquidated by the Management Company. As a rule, investors can redeem their shares on any Luxembourg banking day except 24 and 31 December.

Objectives

The investment policy of Flossbach von Storch SICAV - Multiple Opportunities ('subfund') aims to achieve reasonable capital growth in the sub-fund currency, taking into account the investment risk. The sub-fund is actively managed. The composition of the portfolio is determined by the fund manager in accordance with the criteria defined in the investment policy, reviewed regularly and adjusted if necessary. No comparison with a benchmark index is made. In order to achieve its investment objectives, the SubFund generally has the option, depending on the market situation and the assessment of the fund management, to invest in all assets permitted under the Articles of Association and the section "General provisions of the investment policy", including equities, bonds and money market instruments, units in UCITS or UCIs, precious metals, derivatives and demand deposits. The sub-fund invests more than 25% of its net sub-fund assets in equity investments. The sub-fund

has the option of investing up to 15% of its net sub-fund assets directly (physically) in gold. In addition, the sub-fund has the option of investing up to 10% of its net sub-fund assets indirectly in gold and other precious metals. For reasons of risk diversification, no more than 10% of the sub-fund's net assets may be invested indirectly in any single precious metal. Detailed information on the above and any other investment opportunities of the sub-fund can be found in the currently valid sales prospectus. This sub-fund may not be suitable for investors who wish to keep their capital invested in the sub-fund for less than 4 years.

This share class distributes the income it generates to investors.

The sub-fund promotes environmental or social characteristics within the meaning of Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088. The fund follows a holistic sustainability approach and, as part of its long-term investment strategy, attaches importance to companies dealing responsibly with their environmental and social footprint and actively counteracting the negative effects of their activities.

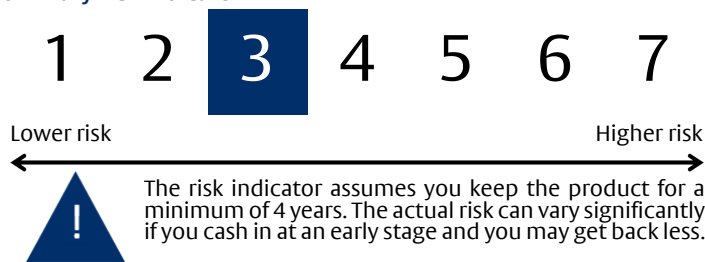
Intended Retail Investor

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Summary Risk Indicator

What happens if Flossbach von Storch Invest S.A. is unable to payout?

The sub-fund assets are segregated from the assets of the Management Company. The Depositary is responsible for holding the assets of the fund in safekeeping. If the Management Company defaults, it will have no direct financial effect on the sub-fund. In addition, the sub-fund assets are segregated from the assets of the Depositary, which reduces the risk of the sub-fund suffering a loss if the Depositary defaults. There is no investor compensation or guarantee scheme if the Management Company or the Depositary defaults.



What are the costs?

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

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How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

Recommended minimum holding period: 4 years

The recommended holding period for the sub-fund is 4 years, as the sub-fund invests for the long term. Investors can sell their shares upon demand on any valuation day (as defined in the sales prospectus).
